The revised NICE guidelines [NG51] were published on 31st January 2024. Our modules have now been updated to include the new recommendations around recognition, diagnosis, and early management of sepsis. Introduction to Sepsis

This module provides a basic overview of the condition and how it presents. It includes real-life video case studies, highlights the importance of speedy recognition of sepsis in both children and adults and introduces NEWS and PEWS scoring to help improve escalation of care. The latest module version (launched March 2024) includes NG51 (2024) including the Sepsis Six, as well as a brand new Summary slide.

Sepsis: A Care Worker's Guide

This module focuses on the identification of sepsis within a care or community setting, the correct actions to take, and how you can save lives. It includes the screening tools available to help establish if a patient has sepsis, guidance on actions to take, preventative measures, and reduction of risk factors. The latest module version (launched March 2024) includes NG51 (2024) updates incorporating revisions to Red and Amber Flag guidance. The module is recommended for all careworkers.

- Outline the risk factors
- Recognise the Red and Amber Flag signs
- Choose appropriate escalation of care

Sepsis in Adults

This module focuses on the causes, signs, and treatment of sepsis in adults, including details of the UKST's 'Sepsis Six' management plan. It includes the screening tools available to help establish if a patient has sepsis, information on NEWS/NEWS2 scoring, Amber and Red Flag guidance and actions, antibiotic treatment, advance directives, preventative measures, and reduction of risk factors. The module is recommended for all clinicians and health workers working with adults. The latest module version (launched March 2024) includes NG51 (2024) updates incorporating revisions to Red and Amber Flag guidance, changes to Risk Stratification information, and increased NEWS2 and Sepsis Six detail.

- Outline the risk factors for adults
- Recognise the Red and Amber Flag signs
- Describe the diagnosis, management, and treatment of adults with sepsis



Sepsis in Children

This module focuses on the causes, signs, and treatment of sepsis in children, including details of the UKST's Paediatric 'Sepsis Six' management plan. It includes the screening tools (according to age and clinical setting) that are available, Amber and Red Flag guidance and actions, and prevention through immunisation. Learners can view either the latest NICE guidelines pathway or, if they are part of an organisation that is piloting or has adopted the new national PEWS tools, they can follow the National PEWS pathway within the module. The module is recommended for all clinicians and health workers working with children. The latest module version (launched March 2024) includes NG51 (2024) updates incorporating revisions to Red and Amber Flag guidance, information relating to common causes of sepsis in children, increased detail on sepsis diagnosis, escalation, management and Sepsis Six and guidance for carrying out face-to-face assessments.
